

Website Accessibility

The WFWI wish to make the WFWI website accessible and user-friendly and wish to develop and maintain the WFWI website within the [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines \(WCAG\) 2.1](#). These guidelines explain how to make web content more accessible for people with disabilities and user friendly for everyone. They have three levels of accessibility: A (lowest), AA and AAA (highest). This website will endeavour over time to meet the majority of relevant and practical AA requirements.

Specific feature of the WFWI website include:

Navigation Aids

- [Return to the homepage](#) - You can return to the homepage at any time by clicking on our name at the top of the page or using the 🏠 button on the right-hand toolbar.
- [Return to the top of the page](#) - You can go to the top of any page by using the ↑ button on the right-hand toolbar.
- [Go to the bottom of page](#) - You can go to the bottom of any page by using the ↓ button on the right-hand toolbar.
- [Search function](#) - The search function in the top right-hand corner of the page sidebar present on every page can be used to find specific pages as an alternative to using the menu function.
